Accident & Incident Investigation 2 Accident Investigation Definitions The Basics Accident: An unexpected incident or exposure that results in an injury or illness to an employee or property damage Incident: Often referred to as a near miss, this is an event that could have resulted in personal harm or property damage

ACCIDENT AND INCIDENT INVESTIGATION PROCEDURE

Incident ~ event that gave rise to an accident or had the potential to lead to an accident Near Miss ~ an event where no ill health, injury, damage, or other loss occurs is also referred to as a 'near-miss' The term 'incident' includes 'near-misses' To identify root causes and effects of an accident

ACCIDENT/INCIDENT INVESTIGATION FORM

A Step-by-Step Guide: Incident Investigations OBJECTIVES

WHEN SHOULD THE INCIDENT INVESTIGATION BE CONDUCTED? • As soon as possible, after the incident occurs or is reported • Before the scene of the incident is disturbed or changed • Before victim(s) and witnesses forget what happened REPORTING OF INJURIES, INCIDENTS AND NEAR-MISSES 1 All injuries, incidents and near-misses should be reported
