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3 Non-verbal predication Non-verbal predication structures (NVPSs) are those in which the semantic relation need not be expressed by a verb (Dik 1980, Hengeveld 1992) Across languages, NVPSs may vary according to (i) the morphosyntactic category of the predicate phrase (ii) the predication type of the clause (ascriptive, equative, presentative)
