GRAMMAR PLURALS POSSESSIVES

The possessive form of a noun indicates ownership To form a possessive, add an apostrophe followed by an s If the noun ends with an s, generally just add an apostrophe (') General Rule To make a singular or plural noun possessive, add an apostrophe followed by an s

ownership or possession Normally these words would be a singular or plural noun, but in the possessive form they are used as adjectives to modify another noun or pronoun Singular Possessive Nouns ! To make a singular noun possessive - add an apostrophe (') and an "s"!
