“Cultural Safety” is a term that emerged from the health sector in New Zealand during the 1990s (Papps & Ramsden, 1996; Ramsden, 2002) The concept and practice of cultural safety grew from an understanding of patient needs in the context of social determinants of health, such as racism and inequality (Paradies et al, 2015)
