The Code Civil The introduction of the Code Civil in France has had its own influence on Jersey contract law The French revolution marked the end of the customary law system in France On the 5th July, 1790, the Assemblée Nationale decided - "... that a code of laws simple and clear and appropriate to the Constitution should be drawn up"

French Corporate Duty Of Vigilance Law

Article 2 of the law - which incorporates an article of the French Commercial Code (Art L 225-102-5) - sends a strong signal to judges Article 2 refers
